# Laboratory Accreditation System Executive Committee Meeting Minutes June 25, 2020 1:30 pm Eastern

### 1) Welcome and Introductions

Maria welcomed everyone to the meeting. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A. Minutes of April 30 were approved (the committee did not meet in May).

This meeting was rescheduled from Tuesday, June 23, at Maria's request, since Tuesdays are not a good time for her. With the committee's assent, future meetings will be held on fourth Thursdays at 1:30 pm Eastern.

The SIR Subcommittee meetings will also need to be rescheduled, and a suitable date will be determined when the subcommittee meets on Monday, June 29, to consider six SIRs in various stages of the process.

2) Discussion of Changes to Consensus Standards Development SOP 2-100 and Need for Corresponding Changes to LASEC and NELAP Standards-related Documents

Lynn presented a brief summary of the changes to SOP 2-100. These are listed below and address all of the points made in LASEC's Lessons Learned document from 2018:

- The terminology for the developing standard has been simplified, and will be "Draft Standard" with any further versions being labeled with the sequential revision number and date approved by the expert committee, as "Draft Standard Revision #, xx/yy/zzzz", for clear identification.
- The vote to approve the new standard (or portion thereof) has always been with the expert committee, which is formally the consensus body. There will no longer be any reference to TNI member voting, although the document approved by the consensus body will continue to be offered for comment to the larger community.
- Timelines for comment will be longer.
- Committee comments will be accepted.
- Many other details of the SOP were modified to accommodate feedback from the ANSI audit, but those do not directly impact LASEC.
- 3) Revisions to NELAP Standards Review and Acceptance SOP 3-103

Lynn prepared and distributed a revision to this document, since LASEC has traditionally been the originator of changes to most NELAP SOPs and policies. None of the edits were substantial – the definitions were updated to match the glossary and information about Volumes 3 and 4 of the TNI Standard now being approved by PTPEC was added. Jack moved and Scott seconded that the document be approved and forwarded to the Accreditation Council for its review and adoption.

During discussion of this SOP, the Chair inquired whether LASEC has need for a voting SOP, and whether there might be need for a roll call vote at any point. This topic may be considered at a future meeting. NOTE: NEFAP EC and PTPEC have voting SOPs, but CSDEC and LASEC do not. The NELAP Voting SOP 3-101 is not applicable to LASEC.

4) Review of Revisions to the LASEC Review of Standards for Suitability SOP 3-106

Lynn prepared and distributed a revision to this document, with changes to accommodate the revisions to SOP 2-100 made. Participants worked through the various sections of the document and its review was valuable since several revisions to various modules of the standard are nearing the Draft Revision stage where LASEC review will be needed. A few minor edits to the revisions and also to the existing wording were requested; those edits will be made and distributed with these minutes, and again for approval at the committee's July meeting.

The only major discussion topic was whether LASEC has a checklist for reviewing standards, but participants concluded that the suitability criteria identified in this SOP are broad generalities, and the variability of content for different modules would make a checklist nearly impossible to create or use. The consensus was that it will be adequate to capture review comments in the meeting minutes.

#### 5) New Business

Lynn noted that the NELAP AC and the NELAP evaluators are expected to reconsider whether to conduct remote site visits for the evaluations underway. One AB's site visit has been "on hold" due to the pandemic emergency for several months now, and the renewal applications for additional ABs are nearing completion of their reviews. If a decision is reached, LASEC may be involved in reviewing the draft protocol for such remote site visits.

At 2:45 pm, David moved and Silky seconded that the meeting be adjourned, and approval was unanimous.

#### 6) Next Meeting

The next scheduled teleconference meeting of LASEC will be <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 23</u>, <u>2020</u>, <u>at 1:30 pm Eastern time</u>. An agenda and documents will be provided prior to the meeting
