4. SLAG Survey

Elizabeth Turner, TNI Small Laboratory Advocate, discussed the survey underway by the Small Lab Advocacy Group. The survey is for all labs, all sizes, both accredited and not accredited, about the awareness of TNI resources available to labs. From the first 2 weeks, 72 labs responded and half of those were unaware of TNI's Small Laboratory Handbook, even though most of the respondents are NELAP-accredited.

The committee asked if Elizabeth could add a question about what is the best way to communicate with labs, and she agreed to do this. The survey will be noted in the News Feed on the TNI web site to encourage participation.

5. Future of Environmental Accreditation – More Planning

Steve summarized the conceptual plan as developed at the January 30 session in Louisville, and noted that we need to identify appropriate questions for the different groups to respond to.

One suggestion was that we need to ask why are they not participating in NELAP. Other suggestions were:

Do you believe in the concept of a national environmental accreditation program?

Do you interact with other certification programs?

What are the benefits of certification or accreditation? Do you see benefits of NELAP above the state by state programs?

Do you recognize other certifications/accreditations?

Do you use any parts of the TNI standard in your non-NELAP program?

The Accreditation Body Database (http://www.nelac-institute.org/abdb.php) is the starting point for identifying state contacts, and to ask if there is anyone else in the state we should speak with. The state calls are slated for March, so that an introductory letter should go out in February.

Steve asked the committee members to send their ideas about issues to discuss directly to him at <<u>steve.arms@flhealth.gov</u>> and noted that he wanted to talk with the committee staff soon about how to proceed.
