Some thought it might send the wrong message to target only young professionals, and we might want to include first time attendees as well. Stacie had previously sent some suggestions for an event by email. There was interest in having a breakfast. Jerry indicated this approach would not incur any additional cost for TNI. This idea will be discussed in more detail at the next meeting.

The next meeting of the Advocacy Committee will be October 1 at 12 Noon CENTRAL time. Steve indicated that he will not be available for the call and that he would like to

appoint a vice chair to help out. Lara indicated that she would be happy to serve as vice chair, but she was unavailable for the next meeting. Lynn Bradley will chair the next meeting.
