2 – Previous Minutes

It was moved by JD and seconded by Nancy to approve the minutes of January 9, 2015. All were in favor.

3 – Crystal City Meeting Planning

Richard shared draft slides he had prepared on LOD and LOQ for presentation at the Crystal City Meeting. Included were: why an LOD and LOQ are required; current definitions and their comparison with Currie's L_c , L_d , and L_q ; proposed new requirements; key components of the LOQ and LOD procedures; specific procedural details; and "big picture" items from the comments received on the Working Draft Standard (WDS). The committee discussed at length the question whether the revised EPA MDL procedure should be mandated. John felt it would simplify the standard and make the requirements more uniform, but Nancy was concerned that some laboratories may have regulatory or client requirements to use a different LOD procedure. Gale agreed, from her experience as an assessor, that other LOD determinations should be allowed. Richard pointed out that the Department of Defense

requires the EPA MDL. Anand said if other LOD options are allowed, there must be criteria for it to be auditable.

The Crystal City agenda was discussed and it was agreed much of the time should be spent on obtaining audience input on the WDS comments.

John said he would be prepared to present additional laboratory data to support the LOQ criteria.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:45 pm EST, with the next meeting scheduled for February 3 in Crystal City.
