

Summary of the TNI Competency Task Force Meeting
Wednesday, January 7, 2021 1:00 pm Eastern

1. Welcome and Roll Call

The Interim Chair, Jerry Parr, welcomed everyone to the meeting. Attendance is recorded in Attachment 1. The minutes of the October 28 and December 2, 2020, meetings were approved by acclamation.

2. Affirmation of Edits to KSA Document from December Meeting

Jerry had updated the draft KSA document before the minutes were written, and some of the agreed-upon edits were missed. He promised to provide evidence of the revisions that were made, and incorporate all revisions including this January meeting into a new draft. A table verifying the revisions from December is included with distribution of these minutes as is the updated draft from the January discussion.

3. Technical Training

After discussion, participants agreed that it would be better to provide less specific course content requirements in order to allow for adaptation to emerging technologies as they arise, thus providing a sense of the desired content but referring to the list of technologies in the Laboratory Accreditation Management Systems (LAMS) database as the ultimate source of technologies to be included. Also, the discussion pointed out that many of the sections in each module are identical (Section 2 of the KSA draft), so that it might be more effective to show the course content in a tabular fashion, with items such as method selection, method validation, demonstration of capability, calibration, etc., on one axis and the discipline modules on the other. Jerry agreed to prepare such a chart and use it rather than the detailed listing initially shown in the KSA draft. These revisions are included in the draft KSA document distributed with these minutes.

In discussion of section 2, which actually occurred after the section 3 discussion, several points were raised.

- Acknowledgement is needed that assessors should not address non-accredited methods (this will go into §1.2.4 instead)
- Add language about assuring that a lab's methods are implemented properly
- 4th paragraph
 - Combine the two sentences into a single sentence
 - In d, remove the term "practices"
 - In h, rephrase to read "traceability in the evaluation..."
 - In "i", rephrase to encompass "regulatory program requirements"

For section 4, about refresher training, the wording should match the language of the standard, which is currently being updated, to say that refresher training is required for all assessors when the standard is updated but may be provided by the accreditation body at other times as desired

4. Next Meeting

The Task Force will not meet during conference. A session titled New TNI Initiatives, scheduled for Wednesday morning, January 27, will include a presentation by Jerry about the Competency Task Force.

The "regular" fourth Wednesday meeting schedule will resume on **February 24, 2021, at 1 pm Eastern**, as conference is the fourth week of January.
