Field Activities Committee (FAC) Meeting Summary

November 23, 2015

1. Roll call and Minutes:

Chair, Justin Brown called the FAC meeting to order on November 23, 2015 at 11am Eastern by teleconference. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A – there were 9 members present. Associate members present: Scott Haas, Nancy Zikmanis, Gavin Armstrong, Michelle Miranda – Eugene, Rich Smith, Skip Darley, and Mike Miller,

2. EPA Sample Containers

Justin gave a brief summary about this action item for new members on the call. The committee was approached to update an EPA document regarding sampling containers. The document was originally written in the 1980's. There were a number of technical specifications that were out of date. People seem to be interested in the document, but the committee has struggled to get volunteers to start the review of this effort. Only one bottle vendor was willing to help and no EPA volunteers stepped forward. There is a subcommittee that has tried to work on it, but they needed more expertise.

Justin recommended moving this topic to the backburner since there are not enough volunteers to work on this. The topic has not generated enough interest to productively work on it.

A motion was made by Larry and seconded by Maggie to place the EPA Sample Container action item on the backburner. The motion was passed unanimously.

3. Charter

Justin distributed the Charter for review today and hopes to finalize any changes in December. He will distribute any changes made today after the call and would then like to receive additional comments by email before the December meeting.

Review:

- Should it be "consensus standard development process"? Yes.
- Skip noticed there is a font issue under Success Measures.

- Milestones. The ANSI process has been started. Justin will update this bullet. This committee is now developing the Scope Guidance document – not assisting.

Maggie confirmed that the next Standard review process won't start until 2017. Justin noted that both ISO 17025 and ISO 17011 are being updated. The anticipated completion date of ISO 17025 is May 2017, so this date should be kept in mind when starting the Standard update.

4. Scope of Accreditation Guidance Document

The committee has tried a few times to begin working on this document during meetings. Progress is not being made. Justin asked for suggestions on how to better work on this document.

It was suggested that a subcommittee work on the document and bring a DRAFT back to the committee. The subcommittee will be formed during the December meeting and be given a Scope/mission to begin work. The following people expressed interest on working on this subcommittee: Larry, Maggie, Troy, Scott Haas and Justin. Justin will send out an email to see if more people would like to participate.

The guidance document is not intended to change the Standard. It is only supposed to clarify the Standard. The industry is very diverse and this makes this action item more difficult. The committee needs to make sure there is input from the various types of FSMOs before the document is finalized.

Field Activities Expert Committee (FAC)

2016 Charter

(Revised: DRAFT-11-23-15)

Mission:

The mission of the TNI Field Activities Committee (FAC) is to develop standards for accrediting bodies and field sampling and measurement organizations. The FAC will engage experts to develop consensus-based standards with the goal of improving the consistency of field methods and the quality of environmental data.

The committee supports the efforts of the National Environmental Field Activities Program (NEFAP) Executive Committee in the implementation of standards by providing technical assistance in developing guidance materials to facilitate adoption and use of these standards on a national and international level. The FAC will establish and maintain an environment for standards development that ensures continual improvement of standards that are aligned with the practical constraints of sampling and field measurement as well as regulatory and industry specific requirements.

Strategic Goals and Objectives:

- Improve the quality and consistency of environmental data by establishing consensus-based standards for activities related to environmental sampling and field measurements.
- Engage experts to develop standards that are practical, appropriate and implementable for organizations of varying size and structure.
- Develop consensus-based standards that are consistent with other national and international standards, avoiding unnecessary duplication and non-value added requirements.
- Establish and evaluate the FAC's success measures to target opportunities for improvement.
- Provide technical assistance in developing the tools (e.g., guidance documents, templates, training materials, etc.) necessary for consistent implementation of the Standard.
- Revise and improve the Standard using the standard development process.
- Provide technical assistance such as responding to Standard Interpretation Requests (SIRs)
- Utilize existing and future TNI infrastructure and resources to accomplish mission.

Success Measures:

- Maintain a diverse group of experts that actively support the FAC.
- Show year over year continued increase in associate committee members.
- Increase stakeholder acceptance of the NEFAP standards including voluntary adoption by accrediting bodies (3rd Party or government agencies), and having standards written into regulation where applicable.
- Prompt responses to SIRs (responses within 60 days).

Key Milestones for 2016:

- Continue the process of ANSI approval for the Standard
- Assist in development of tools for implementation of the Standard
- Development of scope of accreditation guidance document

Considerations:

- Volunteer member organization with significant time constraints
- Ability to identify and engage the industry experts
- Ability to develop consensus-based standards
- TNI field accreditation standards based on ISO Standards which are copyrighted and language is sacrosanct
- Standards must establish a consistent baseline for acceptable field data quality, while providing maximum flexibility to FSMOs to conduct their work.
- Substantial learning curve for FSMOs which have not previously been subjected to rigorous quality requirements and/or accreditation
- Government agencies may have their own standards for field data quality
- Willingness and authority of government agencies to require FSMO accreditation
- Stakeholder "buy-in" and acceptance of the Standard within the industry
- Industry "politics" and prior investments in assuring field data quality
