Attachment E: Final Charter

Field Activities Expert Committee (FAC)

2016 Charter

(Revised: 1-6-16)

Mission:

The mission of the TNI Field Activities Committee (FAC) is to develop standards for accrediting bodies and field sampling and measurement organizations. The FAC will engage experts to develop consensus-based standards with the goal of improving the consistency of field methods and the quality of environmental data.

The committee supports the efforts of the National Environmental Field Activities Program (NEFAP) Executive Committee in the implementation of standards by providing technical assistance in developing guidance materials to facilitate adoption and use of these standards on a national and international level. The FAC will establish and maintain an environment for standards development that ensures continual improvement of standards that are aligned with the practical constraints of sampling and field measurement as well as regulatory and industry specific requirements.

Strategic Goals and Objectives:

- Improve the quality and consistency of environmental data by establishing consensus-based standards for activities related to environmental sampling and field measurements.
- Engage experts to develop standards that are practical, appropriate and implementable for organizations of varying size and structure.
- Develop consensus-based standards that are consistent with other national and international standards, avoiding unnecessary duplication and non-value added requirements.
- Establish and evaluate the FAC's success measures to target opportunities for improvement.
- Provide technical assistance in developing the tools (e.g., guidance documents, templates, training materials, etc.) necessary for consistent implementation of the Standard.
- Revise and improve the Standard using the standard development process.
- Provide technical assistance such as responding to Standard Interpretation Requests (SIRs)
- Utilize existing and future TNI infrastructure and resources to accomplish mission.

Success Measures:

- Maintain a diverse group of experts that actively support the FAC.
- Show year over year continued increase in associate committee members.
- Increase stakeholder acceptance of the NEFAP standards including voluntary adoption by accrediting bodies (3rd Party or government agencies), and having standards written into regulation where applicable.
- Prompt responses to SIRs (responses within 60 days).

Key Milestones for 2016:

- Continue the process of ANSI approval for the Standard
- Assist in development of tools for implementation of the Standard
- Development of scope of accreditation guidance document

Considerations:

- Volunteer member organization with significant time constraints
- Ability to identify and engage the industry experts
- Ability to develop consensus-based standards
- TNI field accreditation standards based on ISO Standards which are copyrighted and language is sacrosanct
- Standards must establish a consistent baseline for acceptable field data quality, while providing maximum flexibility to FSMOs to conduct their work.
- Substantial learning curve for FSMOs which have not previously been subjected to rigorous quality requirements and/or accreditation
- Government agencies may have their own standards for field data quality
- Willingness and authority of government agencies to require FSMO accreditation
- Stakeholder "buy-in" and acceptance of the Standard within the industry
- Industry "politics" and prior investments in assuring field data quality
