Field Activities Committee (FAC) Meeting Summary

February 1, 2012

1. Roll call:

Chair Justin Brown called the FAC meeting to order on February 1, 2012 at 8:30am EST. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A – there were 10 members present.

Justin had the two new committee members introduce themselves: Michael Shepherd and Troy Burrows.

The meeting minutes will be distributed by e-mail and if no comments are received they will be approved and posted to the TNI website.

2. NEFAP Program Overview

See Attachment B for flowchart slide.

The flowchart was reviewed and will be posted on the website under the NEFAP section. The four ABs were announced at the last meeting in Bellevue, WA. One of the ABs has now received an application from an FSMO and thus the program is now working through the final column of boxes.

3. TNI FAC Activities

See slide presentation in Attachment C.

Justin encouraged people to use the Standard Interpretation Request process. The committee will be using these to help update the standard also.

The committee is still taking suggestions as they begin the rewrite of the standard.

4. NEFAP Advocacy Update

See slide presentation in Attachment C.

Please take brochures and give them out as appropriate. JoAnn encouraged everyone to let her know if they are attending any conferences that may be appropriate for a NEFAP presentation. Justin and JoAnn are able to help provide an abstract and presentation for

people to give. These tools are available to people outside of the committee. They can also help write articles as needed.

5. SOP 5-107 Review of Training and Advocacy Materials

The most recent version of the SOP was distributed to committee members last weekend.

Section 1: OK

<u>Section 2</u>: "qualified instructors" – another term is needed. May also need to distinguish between training and advocacy. Advocacy is a presentation. Maybe there are two terms – presenters and instructors. The term "knowledgeable" was inserted instead of "qualified".

It is also important that something be added or clarified that this group is responsible for determining the type of training needed for the program. Perhaps add the term "needed" material.

Nilda noted that she is interested in the committee preparing training material that she can use to help train people in her organization.

Section 5:

Should a conflict of interest form be placed in the appendix? No. It is part of the EDS SOP. Clarify that the chair appoints this subcommittee.

Section 5.3 is not needed because the review of training material may be done by people outside of the training committee too. This ensures that people with the needed knowledge are the ones reviewing the material.

Section 6:

Does training material need to be approved by the entire FAC or is it something handled between the subcommittee and TNI's Training Coordinator. The group determined that the FAC does not need to approve the training. The Training Coordinator will receive the group's recommendation directly from the subcommittee.

The group has decided to separate the SOP into a training material and a separate advocacy SOP. JoAnn will work on the Advocacy SOP.

The TNI EDS SOP needs to be referenced in regards to certificates.

A section is being added to define what a knowledgeable trainer is. JoAnn suggested that trainers be evaluated for knowledge of the materials. What is their background knowledge of the training being presented? The trainers resume should be included in the submission or it can be included in a standardized form where this information is asked for. Dane will work on this form.

Work on the SOP will continue on the next teleconference.

6. Status of Standard Revision

Mike Miller had some suggestions for changes to the standard regarding PTs.

The FSMO shall successfully participate in relevant and available, accredited PT schemes from a TNI Provider (PTP), accredited by a TNI recognized PTP Accreditation Body; unless the FSMO is required to meet other specifier or regulatory program requirements. The Policy Committee did not think this was an appropriate Policy. A TIA or update to the standard should be considered.

Look at 5.9.1(b) (Vol 1): participation in inter-laboratory comparison or proficiency-testing programs.

Look at 7.15 (Vol 2): Proficiency Testing and Other Comparisons for Laboratories

Mike noted that these references don't include by whom. Bob stated that the AB has the choice of who would be an acceptable PT provider.

Marlene shared that the issue came up as the XRF PTs were developed. There was no requirement that these developed PTs would be required.

The question is whether something needs to be added to the standard or would a TIA be beneficial.

Mike reviewed the comments he made on the standard.

Scott was concerned that he would have to run multiple PTs because he might use different technologies for the same analyte. The committee stated that if there are no PTs – there is no requirement to run a PT. FoPTs are developed by people who are familiar with the technology.

Scott suggested looking for more efficient ways to add the language based on looking at what is in Volume 3 and 4 of the PT standard and making sure that not all this language is needed.

Mike Miller submitted suggested changes to the standards by e-mail on 1/19/2012. Committee members should review these.

Suggestions on 7.9.2.1.4 c - 12 month

Bob noted that he is more interested in talking about matrix for PTs instead of technology/analyte.

We received over 100 suggestions for updating the standards.

Audience comments were requested:

- Maria asked if audit samples could be substituted for PTs for stack testers.
- PT samples must take both sampling and measurement into consideration when developing PTs. The language will be critical to keep it broad enough to consider all the different types of sampling.
- A quality manual template, FSMO checklists, links to ABs, etc.

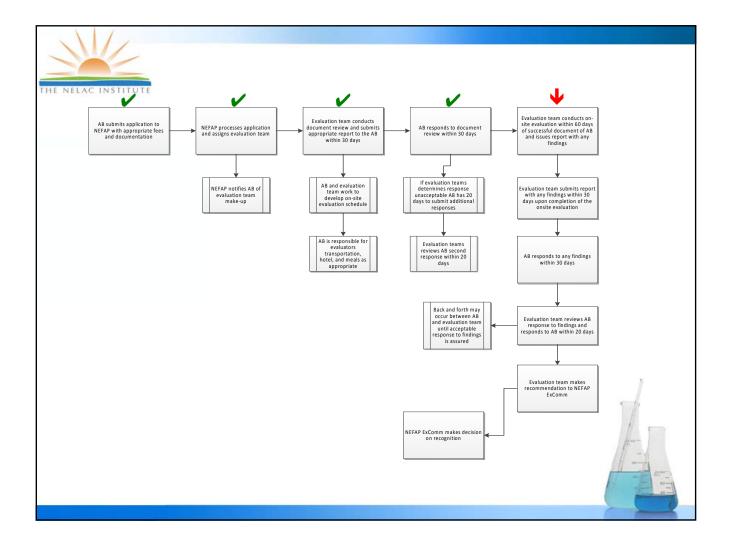
The next meeting of the FAC will be planned by Justin by e-mail.

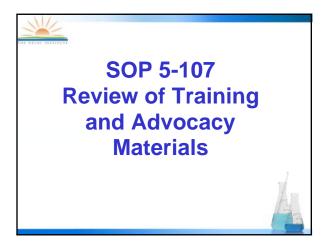
