#### **Field Activities Expert Committee (FAC)**

## Meeting Summary July 2, 2018

#### 1. Roll call:

Chair, Shannon Swantek, called the FAC meeting to order on July 2, 2018 at 11am Eastern by teleconference. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A – there were 10 members present. Associate Members: Justin Brown. Guest: Jacob Grusozki.

Meeting minutes are sent to the committee by email. If no comments are received within one week of the email notification, they are considere, approved and are posted on the TNI website.

#### 2. Update

The Committee will look at plans for the joint meeting in New Orleans the first week of August. Justin and Shannon put a combined agenda together. One of the topics will be to discuss what can be added to the Field Standard to make it more "usable". Many feel there is not enough additional items in the Field Standard for it to make sense to use instead of the actual ISO/IEC 17025 Standard. Adding Statistical Design is one thing that could be added.

#### 3. Subcommittee Update

The mobile lab subcommittee is no longer in place. It has been replaced the new Field Activities Task Force that is reporting to the Board of Directors. It is made up of people with both field and lab backgrounds.

There is no longer a glossary subcommittee. This work is being finalized by the CSDP EC. Each Expert Committee is represented on the CSDP EC.

Shannon would like to suspend work on the Scope Guidance Document until the Committee is moving forward on the Standard rewrite. She would like to focus energy on the Standard.

There is a Tool Subcommittee that can be put back into action once we get closer to updating the Standards.

#### 4. Standard Review

Marlene wanted to make sure that the Committee has not forgotten that she is proposing that the ISO/IEC 17011:2017 update be combined for NEFAP and NELAP. The NELAP people are having trouble addressing the NGAB concerns. Perhaps this is an opportunity to get more States involved in NEFAP. How AB's operate could be equivalent between NEFAP and NELAP. Marlene will keep the Committee up to date on what LAB is doing.

Ilona noted that Field's schedule to update their FSMO Standard is ahead of NELAP's time table to update the Lab Standard. The timing may be similar to NELAP on the Field AB Standard if the Committee wants to consider Marlene's suggestion. Marlene will do a comparison so the Committee can evaluate this suggestion. She will need a copy of the Field Standard to do this comparison. Shannon will discuss this with Marlene. The DRAFT Shannon has been working on has not been reviewed by the Committee yet.

Marlene - Need to keep in mind that we may have State ABs that might need to be taken into account. Previously this was not addressed. Just thought about NGABs.

Marlene has time to review the work done by the format group.

If the joint meeting accomplishes what it should, we should have a good feel of where we go next. There will be further discussion after the special session in New Orleans.

Ilona forwarded a copy of the work Quality Systems did when they decided where the current Standard sections should go into the new ISO/IEC 17025:2017 format. The current Standard is based on 2005 ISO/IEC 17025.

Marlene noted that LAB just moved the language into the new ISO/IEC 17011:2017 Standard and then the committee walked through the Standard and made updates/deletions/additions. Ilona noted this is what Quality Systems is doing now. They just took an additional step where the committee decided where things should go rather than one person making those decisions for further review.

Shannon asked Justin if he thinks the NELAP AC can discuss whether they would agree with having one AB Standard for NELAP and NEFAP based on ISO/IEC 17011:2017. He will suggest this to Kirstin since she will be the Chair of the NEFAP EC in a week. Marlene is concerned the NEFAP EC doesn't understand the opportunity. The joint meeting may help with some of this.

The outline Shannon has been working from is originally from Carl. She received it back in February 2018. Marlene said this has been updated a number of times and it is probably outdated. The current version is June 2018. Ilona noted that what Marlene is talking about is the Module 2 update for the Environmental Laboratory Standard. What Carl sent FAC was a version where he moved language for FAC based on the 2014 Field Standards and the final DRAFT of ISO/IEC 17011:2017. It was intended to give the

FAC a head start. He prepared separate comparison documents for FAC, LAB and Quality Systems Expert Committees. Shannon forwarded Carl's document to Marlene during the call.

Scott moved the 2014 Standard language into the new format and Kira color coded the language.

Marlene noted that when Carl originally looked at the new ISO/IEC 17011:2017 Standard he thought it was all initial assessments, but it was all assessments. She is not sure if Carl had that mindset when he went through FAC's version. She will take a look at the document Shannon just sent and send back comments.

Ilona noted that the Quality System's document you sent will be helpful when the Committee starts working on the FSMO Standard and the ISO/IEC 17025:2017 format update. We'll want to get the most current copy from Paul Junio (Chair, QS) when the Committee starts working on this.

Scott, Kevin, Kira and Shannon will start work on moving the 2014 FSMO Standard into the new ISO/IEC 17025:2017 format. They will only be moving the language.

Shannon asked if more needs to be added to the Field Standard. There are a number of people that don't see the value of NEFAP as an accreditation because it's not much different than the stand alone ISO/IEC 17025.

Marlene does not think it needs to be more detailed. She thinks the issue for why it is not being used is because it is not mandatory. NEFAP hasn't hit the right people that can require its use. Our industry still looks at the lab as doing all the work, but normally the laboratory doesn't do the sampling part of it.

Marlene is concerned that a more proscriptive TNI Field Standard will turn off EPA's interest because this is part of why they don't like NELAP. Perhaps becoming more proscriptive in statistical planning would help the standard. This will make it more consistent with EPA's philosophies on how to do sampling and measurement.

Kevin commented that more value needs to be added to the Standard. Ilona noted that Jerry Parr commented that the NEFAP Standard looks too much like it is just ISO/IEC language.

Kevin also noted that the new ISO language takes away from the old ISO language. We need to be sure to look at what ISO language is missing in the new Standard and decide if FAC wants to add it back in.

What are elements we can add to the Field Standard that would be helpful to users of the Standard.

Shannon asked if the committee can review the DRAFT and comment where the 2014 Standard language went in the new format. Shannon will send a formal request to the Committee members and associates by email. The due date for comments will be July 16, 2018. She will take the info from everyone and compile it, and then send this to

Marlene for her comments based on the work LAB is doing. Scott, Kira, Kevin and Shannon will take all the comments (including Marlene's) and prepare a new DRAFT.

Shannon will also send out the LAB document to the committee to help them with their review.
