Field Activities Expert Committee (FAC)

Meeting Summary February 14, 2019

1. Roll call:

Chair, Shannon Swantek, called the FAC meeting to order on February 14, 2019 at 11am Eastern by teleconference and Webex. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A – there were 9 members present. Associate Members: David Fricker, Theresa Rojas and Michelle Miranda.

Meeting minutes are sent to the committee by email. If no comments are received within one week of the email notification, they are considered approved and are posted on the TNI website.

2. Milwaukee

It was cold, but the meeting was productive. The combination of the 2014 NEFAP Standard with the new ISO/IEC 17025:2017 Standard was completed. Scott made changes as the committee came to decisions of where language went. It is now one consolidated document. The next step is look for duplicated language.

Ilona noted that the NEFAP EC will be helping to complete the update to the Scope Guidance document so that FAC can focus on the Standard.

3. Combined DRAFT NEFAP Standard

Scott pulled up the combined document (ISO/IEC 17025:2017 and 2014 FSMO Standard) completed in Milwaukee on Webex. The Committee then started reviewing the document from the top for duplicate language. He made the changes and deletions directly into the document using Track Changes.

Discussion:

Notes are not requirements. Leave in Section 1.3, because it is not in the 2017 Standard. This 2005 italicized language will later become "TNI language".

See comment for laboratory definition. Section 5.6 - It should be more than what is currently in the Standard. Marlene noted that we have sampling that doesn't require subsequent testing. Scott asked how sampling can relate to calibration? Marlene is looking at sampling that doesn't have subsequent testing or calibration. Scott captured these thoughts in the comment he placed in the document.

Shannon asked if assignments should be made for people to begin adding language to the Standard. Everyone agreed it would be better to wait until DMS is ready and duplicate language is removed.

Ilona commented that she thinks decisions are being made about language, but that was not the intended purpose of this meeting. We are only supposed to be removing duplicate language.

Changes made to the document during today's meeting can be found in Attachment E. The Committee ended at Section 6.2.

The Committee decided to hold an additional meeting on March 19, 2019 at 11am Eastern to make more progress.

4. Internal Audit

Kevin stepped up to help provide a DRAFT of the Internal Audit for the FAC. Ilona will work with Kevin, Shannon and Scott to finish this.

5. Membership

David Fricker applied for membership to the Committee and his resume was distributed by email.

Scott and Andora are eligible for a second term on the Committee. Marlene moved to approve Scott and Andora for a second term on the FAC. The motion was seconded by Elizabeth. There was no further discussion and the motion was unanimously approved.

Marlene motioned to add Scott as Chair of the FAC. Scott agreed to the nomination/motion. The motion was seconded by Doug and unanimously approved.

Scott motioned to add Shannon as Vice-Chair of the FAC. Shannon agreed to the nomination/motion. The motion was seconded by Keith and unanimously approved.

Scott thanked Kevin for his help in the Chair and Vice-Chair role these last 5 years.
