Laboratory Accreditation System Executive Committee Meeting Minutes Thursday, February 18, 2021 1:30 pm Eastern

1) Welcome and Introductions

Maria welcomed everyone to the meeting. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A. Minutes of December 17 were approved unanimously and the minutes of the January 28 conference session were approved with Aaren and Mike abstaining.

2) Election for 2021 Membership and Leadership

Re-election of one member, Silky Labie, for a second term was overlooked in December. Louise moved and Aaren seconded that Silky be approved for a second term and all present voted in favor. Thank you for continuing, Silky!

3) Updates from Conference

The LASEC session is summarized in the January 29 minutes as approved.

Dorothy reported that the Mentor Session was well attended (approximately 175 participants) with good presentations. The lack of interaction made this conference's session much different than others in recent history but there were many more attendees, so people who could not have participated for an in-person conference were able to join in. The late afternoon networking session also went well. Several potential topics for the summer conference scheduled for Bellevue, WA, were mentioned – control limits, evaluating outliers, what constitutes a gross failure and what defines a claim of accreditation, plus possibly detection limit issues.

The Assessment Forum had no one present to report, but Maria committed to watching the video and reporting at the March meeting.

4) Still More Revisions to SIR Management SOP 3-105

A revised draft reflecting the additional edits requested in December was distributed. Since that time, LASEC was asked to add a clause to §5.4.2 about removing personally identifiable information or in appropriate language from submitted interpretation requests, so that language was also added to this latest draft.

Members decided this clause should also be added as a footnote on the SIR submission form. Stacey moved and Mike seconded a motion to that effect, and approval was unanimous. That request has been sent to the webmaster.

5) Review of V2M1 Draft Standard

The comment period for the Draft Standard V2M1 was extended to March 28 at the request of the NELAP AC. No comments were offered by LASEC members in response to the Chair's request for review and comment. Final comments will be considered at the March 18 meeting, if any are offered.

6) New Business

There was no new business.

Mike moved and Harold seconded that the meeting be adjourned.

9) Next Meeting
