## Laboratory Accreditation System Executive Committee Meeting Minutes August 7, 2013 Forum on Laboratory Accreditation, San Antonio, TX

### 1) Welcome and Roll Call

Judy Morgan welcomed everyone to the meeting. Committee members in attendance are noted in Attachment A, but the teleconference line proved unworkable.

#### 2) Updates

## Merger of Technical Assistance Committee with LAS EC

After Denver, the Executive Director recommended that these two committees be merged. That was accomplished during February and March of 2013, with a few people dropping out altogether but still leaving more than fifteen (15) interested in participating with the combined committee, so there is a substantial roster of active Associate committee members in addition to the TNI Small Laboratory Advocate (an Ex Officio member.) There are three standing subcommittees in the combined LAS EC – one for Mentor Sessions, one for the Assessment Forum, and one for Standards Interpretation Requests (SIRs.) Other short-term tasks will typically be accomplished by an *ad hoc* group appointed by the chair according to member interests and availability. Thus far, three of these *ad hoc* groups have been appointed. Two are underway and nearing completion – revising the SIR SOP and reviewing and revising the NELAP Evaluation SOP. The third group drafted a policy, already adopted by the NELAP Accreditation Council (AC,) concerning what changes to Accreditation Body operations trigger a requirement that the AC be notified and how to determine whether additional information or some degree of re-evaluation might be required.

#### SIR Subcommittee

Since the merger was completed, nearly all of the backlogged SIRs have been reviewed and either closed out as "not a SIR," returned to the expert committee for adjustment, or have been re-posted to the AC voting site with or without modifications. A very small number of SIRs await some other form of resolution.

Judy noted that the next step, after conference, will be to develop Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs, with answers) as a way of clarifying the implementation of or compliance with the standard – where the requirement may be clear but questions repeatedly arise about how to meet the requirement. She envisions several different ad hoc groups working on different categories of FAQs, and hopefully to have the first set completed by conference in Louisville, KY (January 2014.) Committee members interested in contributing to this process should notify Judy or Lynn.

#### **NELAP Evaluation SOP Working Group**

This document was revised by the informal group of NELAP evaluators, to address "streamlining" changes recommended by the NELAP QA Officer. It is being formally reviewed by the LAS EC and revised in accordance with the very recent decision by the NELAP AC about how it will utilize third party (contract) evaluators. Once approved by the full LAS EC, it will be forwarded to the NELAP AC for approval and adoption, and then on to the Policy Committee.

#### Standards Review SOP

Judy noted that the Consensus Standards Development Executive Committee is in the final stages of preparing or revising its Standards Review SOP, to conform to the recommendations of the Corrective Action Review group. Once that SOP is finalized, the LAS EC will develop a companion SOP for review of Environmental Laboratory Sector standards as preliminary to recommending them to the NELAP AC for adoption.

#### 3. SIR SOP

The workgroup product was distributed to the committee for review, and was reviewed in detail during this meeting. In particular, the concept of creating "clarifications" in the form of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for requests that do not qualify as SIRS was well received. Additional revisions were made during discussion and several items were identified for a "global search and replace" of terminology, as the committee and meeting participants worked through the entire draft document. At the end of this discussion, Committee members decided to initiate a vote to approve the revised SOP, with absent members being sent the revised draft and being allowed to vote after receipt. Carl made the motion and Barbara seconded; seven (7) "yes" votes were recorded, with 8 absent committee members to be polled once the revised document is available to be circulated. [NOTE: this revision is still being prepared as of 8/22/2013.)

A request from the floor that individuals can request to be notified when the Interpretations page of the TNI website is updated has been forwarded to the TNI webmaster.

#### 4. Next Steps

All groups with un-completed tasks will continue. The new items on the horizon (a standards review SOP and the SIR FAQs) will be addressed after conference. The Assessment Forum and Mentor Session had successful sessions at conference and now will begin planning for conference in Louisville.

JoAnn moved and Kristin seconded that the meeting be adjourned.

#### 5) Next Meeting

The next meeting of the LAS EC will be Tuesday, August 27 at 1:30 pm Eastern. A meeting announcement will be sent.
