Microbiology Expert Committee (MEC) Meeting Summary

June 24, 2014

1. Roll Call and Minutes:

Robin Cook, Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:40pm Eastern by teleconference. Attendance is recorded in Attachment A – there were 5 members present. The following associate members were also present: Jennifer Best (EPA) and Amy Hekmen (Pennsylvania – stepping in for Dwayne).

The minutes were not reviewed due to low attendance at the meeting. The minutes will be reviewed by email or at the next meeting.

Associate members need to let Robin and Ilona know they own a copy of ISO 17025 so they can be included in distributions of the draft working standard updates.

2. Next Steps

Ilona described the next steps. The Standard will be completed today and then Robin and Ilona will prepare it to go to Jan (TNI) for any format and typo cleanups. The committee will then vote to approve the standard as a Working Draft Standard. This all needs to be done before July 3rd so it can be posted in time to use the Washington, DC meeting as the public presentation of the Standard. We will also set-up a Webinar for that meeting so people who cannot be in DC can still hear the review. The Standard needs to be publically posted for at least 30 days before this meeting.

3. Standard Review

All of the sections have now been reviewed. Robin wanted review a few controversial sections before the Standard is finalized.

Section 1.7.3.7 b) i) Temperature Measuring Devices:

Robin clarified that the section discusses thermometers. It is not talking about incubators. There was agreement to leave the language as it is. Robin commented that additional information could be included in the handbook that the Quality Systems Expert Committee is working on.

Section 1.7.3.7 b) ii):

Robin reviewed the language after Autoclave maintenance. She cleaned up a few grammatical issues, but left the basic language as it has been.

She did add some language to b) that was captured in the DRAFT Standard.

Section 1.7.3.7 b) iii):

Delete the last line regarding DW requirements. It is not appropriate to include this in the standard. It might be appropriate to include this in the handbook instead.

<u>1.7.5 a) i):</u>

Concerns were raised about putting in two hours. It was changed to something along the lines of sufficient cooling time rather than specifying a time. It must be nestled in ice.

Surface Water rules would not allow an exception to temperature. This could be included in the handbook.

1.7.3.7 b) v):

There were no additional comments given. Green language will be reviewed before it is deleted to make sure nothing was accidently deleted.

Open Discussion:

Jennifer asked if the language regarding expired media was deleted. Robin looked through the standard. Need to rewrite 1.7.3.1 b i) – need to still remove the language and Robin will clean this up within the numbering because a section is being deleted. Additional language was added to "Any ready-to-use media …" shall be used by the expiration date provided by the manufacturer.

Ilona asked about track changes. It looked like the changes being made were not all being tracked. Robin and Ilona will work on the standard to make sure all the changes are tracked by comparing the old and new standard.

The goal is to have the Standard ready for posting on July 3rd. Everyone was asked to watch for emails with any final comments.

The vote will be handled by email.

Deb Waller motioned to approve the Microbiology (EL-V1M5) Working Draft Standard as updated by Robin Cook and described in an email sent to the Expert Committee on June 30, 2014. The motion was seconded by Elizabeth Turner.
