NEFAP Executive Committee Meeting Summary March 8, 2012

1. Roll call:

Chair Marlene Moore called the NEFAP Executive Committee meeting to order on Thursday, March 8, 2012 at 1:00pm EST. Attendance is included in Attachment A. There were 9 committee members present.

The minutes from the Sarasota (Feb 1st) meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Doug L. and seconded by John. The minutes were unanimously approved.

The minutes from the February 17th meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Kim and seconded by Mike. The minutes were unanimously approved.

2. FSMO Checklist

The final language needs to be added to this checklist so that it can be posted on the website. Marlene is working on this.

3. Nominations

Be sure to get short biographies to Ilona for inclusion on the voting site by tomorrow (Fri, 3/9). She is passing them on to William as he develops the voting process.

4. Washington, DC Meeting

The field portion of the meeting is happening at the beginning of the week. Meetings will be on August 6th and 7th. There is also an NEMC session that will be relevant to Field.

Marlene is also working with EPA on example language for contracts that encourage the use of accredited samplers. She and Justin will be doing a DoD presentation in the next two weeks that will include encouragement to use accredited samplers.

7. Evaluation SOP

The committee needs to more thoroughly discuss the concept of the Recognition Council so that Doug L. knows what to include in the Evaluation SOP.

When the initial SOP was written there was no thought of anti-trust laws, but more recent review by one of the ABs has raised this concern. Should the entire EC be voting on the approval of ABs? Doug L. proposed a Recognition Council as a means to address this. This sets up an additional layer in the program. The potential concern is that the ABs can automatically accept all the ABs (monopoly) or some ABs could be rejected to give another AB a competitive advantage. Both are issues in the United States.

A small selective group could be developed called a Recognition Council. They would be appointed by the Executive Committee. They would be TNI members and they need to be familiar with how ABs do their business. A Recognition Council SOP will be needed to detail their make-up and processes. This is what Doug L. will be working on. Training should also be included in this.

The EC appoints the Council and it is still responsible for documents, processes, procedures, etc... for NEFAP. The EC is still needed. There may also be some EC members on the Council.

Calista expressed concerns about inconsistency if the Recognition Council make-up were constantly changing. Marlene expressed a similar concern at the last meeting.

Marlene noted that the council reviews the evaluation information and ensures that everything is complete. They are also looking for consistency and bias. John commented that if bias is a concern, what is the subjectivity that is in the evaluation process? Marlene pointed out that PTs are a potential issue.

We need to have this Evaluation SOP updated as soon as possible. If it is not complete by the time the first FSMO is assessed and an AB evaluation is ready to be completed ... the current process will be followed. Everyone was reminded that the NEFAP EC did vote on the preliminary reports from the Lead Evaluators to preliminarily approve the ABs. This was done because there was nothing in the SOP regarding preliminary approval. This is not the case with the final AB approval. This is part of the Evaluation SOP.

A back-up option might be to have every member of the EC state what their conflicts of interest are. Based on this information, it can be determined who can vote. An FSMO may have a conflict because they will be choosing an AB to apply to. ABs may have conflicts because they are competitors of other ABs. Is there anyone that does not have any conflicts? This information may help Doug L. work on the Recognition Council SOP.

Ilona will collect the information regarding conflicts of interest and prepare a summary document. Marlene will prepare an e-mail that will go out to everyone requesting the information. It will be some type of form so the information is received in a consistent format to make the summary easier. Doug L. should continue to work on the Recognition Council SOP. We need to keep multiple things happening at the same time due to time limitations.

Everyone needs to look at Tracy's draft Evaluation SOP, the last minutes, these minutes and anything Doug L. gets to the group before the next meeting.
