## Summary of the NELAP Accreditation Council Meeting January 3, 2011

#### 1. Roll call

The NELAP Accreditation Council (AC) met at 1:30 PM EST on January 3, 2011. Those members in attendance are listed in Attachment 1.

### 2. Minutes

Minutes from the 12-20-10 meeting were reviewed and approved for posting as presented.

#### 3. Next round of evaluations

Renewal letters for KS, LADHH, and NH were sent on December 22, 2010. Requests for time extensions to submit renewal applications have been made by at least two of the ABs. Aaren asked for discussion about whether extensions ought to be granted, and whether the full Council needed to approve extensions. Because these letters arrived during the holidays, and also because the evaluation teams cannot receive the required training at least until February 4, 2011, and for those who must await the online training, possibly as late as mid-March, consensus was that these extensions are reasonable requests and ought to be granted by the Chair, and that future extension requests could be decided by the Chair.

Team assignments were approved for PA, UT, and NY, as follows. Renewal letters will be prepared for the Chair's signature by the date shown below. IN the case of PA, the Vice Chair will send the renewal letter.

PA – Steve Gibson (TX) and Joe Slayton (EPA R3) UT – Fred Choske (CA) and Gabriele Thompson (EPA R7) NY – Scott Hoatson (OR), Donna Ringel/Linda Mauel (EPA R2),Susan Wyatt (MN) observing

New York inquired why they will have a larger team size, with the response being that it's partly because of the single tier and large program size, but also the decision of the EPA Region to send both the QA Manager and the Drinking Water Certification Officer, as well as having a volunteer observer (a new AB representative) who wishes to obtain additional training as an evaluator.

#### 4. Review and Approval of the Voting SOP revisions

The draft changes to the 12/22/10 draft of the NELAP Voting SOP were reviewed and discussed. Additional specific changes were determined, and a revised draft will be circulated in advance of the next AC meeting. Explicit definitions for the 4 possible types of vote will be included in the SOP, and the option of referring any unresolved "veto" votes to the Consensus Standards Development Executive Committee will be omitted, since the ABs do not believe that the CSD should have decision authority over the NELAP AC.

Several issues were discussed, including how votes would be counted when non-voters are actually listed in the SIR voting site (online). All who have access to view the SIRs are listed as potential voters, due to the way the site is constructed, but when the SIR Program Administrator determined that 2/3 votes have been cast, s/he will not be counting comments or votes from any but AB representatives.

The Chair asked to pass over the agenda item of formal voting on the "historical" outstanding SIRs, since the later agenda items urgently required discussion and resolution and there was only a quarter hour remaining on the call.

#### 5. Possible Routine Inclusion of non-AB Representatives on AC teleconferences.

A TNI member had asked to be notified of the call-in number for all future AC teleconferences. In addition, the possibility of having a representative from the Proficiency Testing Executive or Expert Committee as an "ex officio" member of the AC had been raised in conversations. The Chair sought input from AC members about these possibilities before making a final decision.

General consensus of the participants was that additional persons may be invited to participate in AC meetings on a case-by-case basis, and this could include TNI members requesting to participate in specific meetings, but that first, the AC is not a consensus committee and is not obligated to hold open meetings, and second, many topics discussed at AC meetings deserve some degree of confidentiality even if not warranting a formally "closed session" – specific issues may arise that ought not be subject for public discussion until the ABs have made a decision, for example, the renewal recommendations from the evaluation teams.

## 6. Next meeting

The next regular conference call of the NELAP AC should be on **TUESDAY**, **January 18**, **2011**, at 1:30 pm Eastern, due to the Martin Luther King, Jr., holiday on Monday.

Potential agenda items will include:

- Approval of minutes
- Update on renewals, including training attendance
- Review and approval of the Voting SOP revisions and consideration of the SIR SOP revisions
- Formal voting on the outstanding SIRs that were presented during the 12/8/10 meeting, individually with additional online votes that may have been cast since they were reposted taken into consideration
- Decisions about agenda for NELAP AC session in Savannah
- Other items as may become known
