Summary of the NELAP Accreditation Council Meeting March 18, 2013

1. Roll call and Approval of Minutes

The NELAP Accreditation Council (AC) met at 1:30 pm EDT on Monday, March 18, 2013. Minutes of the March 4, 2013, meeting were approved. Michelle Wade led the meeting, since neither the Chair nor the Vice Chair was able to participate.

Those members in attendance are listed in Attachment 1.

Steve Gibson announced that two training events are being planned in TX for the week prior to our next conference in San Antonio. While not confirmed yet, there will potentially be both technical training on assessing organic tests on July 29 and 30 at TCEQ's offices in Austin and basic assessor training [not sponsored by TCEQ] on July 31 to August 2 in either Austin or San Antonio. Marlene Moore is slated to be the instructor.

2. Action Items Pending

- Susan and Stephanie O. agreed to draft a position paper on crypto accreditations.
- Lynn will SOP 1-102 (AC Voting) per discussion at this meeting, and distribute prior to April 15 meeting.
- Discuss w/ full AC whether and how to address different practices among ABs that came to light during the December 3, 2012, meeting
- SIR workgroup to modify remaining unapproved recommendation for SIR #81 and #125.
- Final Response to Complaint from ACIL pending completion of evaluation process for the AB (site report sent to CA)

3. NELAP Voting SOP 3-102 – Addressing Comments from Policy Committee Review

Participants reviewed the revised draft incorporating items discussed at the Council's March 4 meeting. Particular items to be incorporated into the next revision are:

- TIA is Tentative Interim Amendment, not Temporary
- The general business quorum will be "simple majority" or one more than half of the membership
- Section 6.3.3.2 will be reworded to avoid the term "invalid" but to clarify that if a quorum of votes are not received, the AC may re-consider the motion and re-vote on it.
- Add the word "requests" to the header of 6.3.7
- Regardless of what we call it, an AB's declaration that it would be unable to implement
 a SIR interpretation must be dealt with; all favor some form of discussion with the
 group that prepared the interpretation, to minimize the effort needed to accommodate
 that AB's conflict, since a state that cannot implement an interpretation would
 otherwise be forced out of NELAP
- It's very important to distinguish between "interpretation" and "clarification" (NOTE: the LAS is working on processes to do exactly that.)

Another revision addressing these items will be available in time for the April 15 meeting.

4. Crypto Position Statement

The draft of this document is approaching completion.

Several ABs expressed concerns about being unable to participate in the training and difficulties in incorporating accreditation for crypto into the state's processes.

5. Next Meeting

The next AC meeting will be Monday, April 1, 2013. This will be the second planned assessor call, and the topic will be Internal Audits. PA will lead the discussion

The April 15, 2013, AC meeting will resume review and discussion of the AC's Voting SOP and possibly the draft crypto position statement, plus any other issues that may arise in the interim.
