Alfredo asked members to review minutes of the previous meeting and send any corrections to Carol.

2. Update on NGAB activities

Alfredo delivered the attached presentation on the status of recognition of NGABs to accredit laboratories to the TNI standard.

Questions and comments from the presentation included:

Can NGABs accredit for drinking water?

No, states have to be primary, but NGAB could do an accreditation and the state can affirm it.

Can the umbrella under which the NELAP AC and potentially the TNRC are located be called "Laboratory Accreditation Program"? This may resolve concerns about wording and naming.

We should look at a way to address concerns without introducing new and confusing nomenclature.

After discussion, Jerry suggested that for now we recommend leaving the TNRC in its current location reporting to the TNI Board. We can then continue to work to resolve organizational issues with the NELAP AC.

Dan Hickman reported that he is working on adjustments to LAMS so that NGABs can enter their accredited labs. It was suggested that we could also put FSMOs in the database. Dan needs more information on what we would like to see in LAMS for NGABs.
