# TNI Policy Committee Meeting Summary Friday, March 1, 2013

#### 1. Welcome, Roll Call and Announcements

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 11 am Eastern. Attendance is recorded in Appendix A. Alfredo asked members to be sure and review the minutes of the February 15 meeting and provide any comments within one week.

#### 2. Continued Review of Draft Revisions to SOP 1-101, "Operations of TNI Committees"

A revised draft from our previous meeting plus additional comments from Alfredo were reviewed. Revisions agreed upon by participants included:

- A definition of "executive committee" is needed.
- In section 7.2.6, we need to avoid the impression that there "must" be 15 committee members.
- Section 7.5 should be retained.
- Section 7.6 should be retained with edits as noted, since its deletion was an error.
- "Register" is not the correct word for Associate Members; wording should be revised.
- A second section for the "no proxies" sentence is needed in 7.7.

Mei Beth moved and Silkie seconded that the revised draft of SOP 1-101 be approved; all present voted "yes." This revised version will be circulated to all impacted committee chairs with a 2-week turnaround, and final approval requested at the April 10, 2013, Board meeting unless committee chairs object.

# 3. Continued Review of Provisional Recognition SOP 3-108, "Issuance of Provisional Recognition of Accreditation Bodies According to the TNI Standard"

Susan's analysis of Chapter 6 of the 2003 NELAC Standard to identify any other items not addressed in current NELAP policies or SOPs was not yet complete, but review continued since this Provisional Recognition (PR) status may be needed in the near future. (NOTE: the NELAP Accreditation Council is aware of Susan's work.) Sections 3 and 4 of this SOP were considered, with discussion that the reason for needing PR status as affecting the "integrity of the accreditation program" was inadequate, but that specific conditions should be set forth. Lynn noted that any punitive action towards a NELAP Accreditation Body is considered not to affect the state, which may continue accrediting labs for its own needs, but rather would negatively impact the accredited laboratories, instead.

Review of this SOP will resume with Section 5.0, at the March 15 meeting.
