1Summary of the TNI Policy Committee Meeting

JANUARY 7, 2008

The Policy Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on January 7, 2007 at 2:00 PM (ET) by teleconference.

Chairperson Mr. Alfredo Sotomayor, of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, led the meeting. A list of committee members is given in Attachment A. A list of the action items generated during this meeting and of uncompleted ones generated during previous meetings is included in Attachment B. The meeting agenda is given in Attachment C.

ATTENDANCE, ANNOUNCEMENTS, AND STATUS OF ACTION ITEMS

Mr. Sotomayor welcomed members and reviewed the status of action items. He informed the committee that Dr. Kenneth Jackson felt that the endorsement of the procedures and policies of the Consensus Standards Development Program could be postponed and considered after the Newport meeting.

Mr. Sotomayor sent a message to committee members prompting them for information on the policies and procedures that programs planned on completing.

Mr. Jerry Parr forwarded to Ms. Jan Wlodarski the changes noted by the committee to the standard operating procedure's template (SOP).

The committee intended to dedicate the rest of the meeting to working on its presentation and session in Newport.

COMMITTEE PRESENTATION IN NEWPORT (JAN. 15. 2008)

The committee continued to work on the presentation to be given at the Newport meeting on Tuesday morning using a first draft forwarded by Mr. Sotomayor. Among the items discussed were:

- Listing the SOPs and policies the committee had developed.
- Including a slide documenting the hierarchy of TNI normative documents and how several had to be consulted to understand a process.
- Providing a slide indicating how to implement the decision-making SOP before the one establishing the "roadmap".
- Using a real example to illustrate the "meta-decision" concept, perhaps relating it to decisions made by the proficiency testing (PT) program.

Mr. Sotomayor will include the suggested changes and have a second draft to work on for the committee's working session in Newport.

COMMITTEE SESSION IN NEWPORT (JAN. 14, 2008)

The committee reiterated that its committee session would be dedicated to completing the presentation to be delivered the following day. Mr. Sotomayor and Mr. Parr did not anticipate a high attendance for the session. Mr. Sotomayor will draft an agenda for the session.

The committee will meet in Newport on January 14, 2008 at 8:30 AM (PT) and will deliver a presentation on the Decision-Making SOP the following day.
