MINUTES OF THE NELAC INSTITUTE'S PROFICIENCY TESTING EXPERT COMMITTEE April 19th, 2011

Agenda Item 1: Standing Committee Operations

The Proficiency Testing (PT) Expert Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met by conference call on April 19, 2011. Committee Chairperson Kirstin McCracken led the call.

Agenda Item 1: Review V1 WDS

The committee began review of the proposed changes for V1 WDS. The group decided that it would be best to add requirements for various technologies in the body of the module. Definitions were reviewed and it was decided the committee cannot make changes to definitions that may be program defined. Kirstin noted that Jerry Parr had asked the group to reconsider the definition of FoPT. After discussion it was decided the definition is as intended but the application of the definition of FoPT is not being used properly by the PT Executive Committee and the AC; this is a program issue and needs to be addressed by the program. Kirstin will notify the LASC, the PT Executive Committee and the TNI Board of Directors requesting their input for resolution. The other changes to the definitions were found acceptable. The committee reviewed the proposed language for other sections and generally found the proposal acceptable except for the language regarding time-frame between open/close/ship dates of successive studies. Kirstin and Steve adamantly propose that the time-frame serves a purpose in the standard and is instead a logistics concern for some ABs. Others think that there should be a minimum time frame. Shawn reminded the group that during the AC call the ABs indicated that they do not want to receive PT reports out of chronological order. All agreed the debate is circular and it needs to be resolved. This topic was tabled for the next call along with the clause for reporting multiple methods.

Need to revisit clauses e and f. - Shawn ask AC and also ask National Database - these enough

Move 4.1.2 to 7.0 What is the purpose of the NOTE in standards? Shawn to ask AC and Change title of Section 6.0 - 6.2-Keep clause but change language to be clear with intent

Def of FoPT in TNI does not match NELAC 2003

Use special QC to assure lab passes PT- Mitzi clause
