### MINUTES OF THE NELAC INSTITUTE'S PROFICIENCY TESTING COMMITTEE CONFERENCE CALL May 13, 2008 (DRAFT)

#### **Agenda Item 1: Standing Committee Operations**

The Proficiency Testing (PT) Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met by conference call on May 13, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. Eastern Time (ET). The call ended at 1:50 PM ET. Committee member Curtis Wood led the call.

**Call to Order:** The teleconference was called to order at 1:05 PM ET.

#### Approval of Minutes from 04/08/2008 Teleconference

CJW read the list of action items, with completion dates, from the April 8th call. CJW indicated that the title of the action items table on page 4 should be changed. No other comments or edits were presented relating to the minutes. TM moved that the minutes be accepted, RH seconded. Vote Tally: 5 Yes, 0 No, 0 Abstain. (AM was not on the call for this vote) Motion passes. Action Item: CJW will forward the approved minutes, with the corrected date, to Kirstin for distribution and posting.

#### **Agenda Item 2: PT Frequency Update**

DT provided an update as to the PT Frequency subcommittee. DT and JL will design data review studies to look at data from labs that perform 1 PT/year and those that perform 2 PT/year. The subcommittee will get feedback from ABs related to PT frequency. They will also talk to PT Providers about what non-NELAC PT requests they get from other ABs, industries, customers, etc. The subcommittee is hold conference calls every 2 weeks which are open to members and associates. Expects to have data to present at the August 2008 TNI meeting. SA indicated that he has seen an average 5% improvement in failure rates for labs that perform 2 PT/year versus those that perform 1 PT/year. He asked what the subcommittee would recommend if their data showed the same. DT indicated that the subcommittee's charge does not include making recommendations, just gathering and presenting data. JL indicated that the data SA is referring to would be beneficial for the committee's work and asked that he submit it to DT. SA said he would talk to people within his company to see if he could do this.

#### **Agenda Item 3: Hold for Next Revision Comments**

The committee continued its discussion of the "Hold for Next Revision" comments.

Comment 6: MS – By taking method out we could be alienating the DW program. AM – Suggested we talk to EPA DW officials. RH – EPA is just now beginning to buy into NELAC, would we risk pushing them away by going against their program. AM indicated that he will be at EPA offices in Cincinatti in early June and will attempt to talk to people from the Drinking Water program about this. Action Item: AM will discuss this issue with representatives of the EPA Drinking Water program and report back to the PT Committee by June 18, 2008.

Comment 467, comment by Dale Piechocki related to PTs by method (no number), and comment 516: AD – Large labs have multiple accreditations so they have to analyze by multiple methods within a tech. Therefore they are not able to just use one method per technology. It may be easier to keep the requirement as is for legislative process that states will have to go through in order to incorporate NELAC program. AM – Methods that are used can change while available technologies stay fairly consistent. Don't need to change legislation. AM suggested the following language for a response - "Nonpersuasive: The current standard incorporates requirements of current and potential NELAC states. Changes at this point could result in problems for both groups concerning the legislative process."

AM – motion to accept reseponse as read, RH – seconded the motion. Vote Tally: 6 Yes, 0 No, 0 Abstain. Motion passes.

The remaining "Hold for next revision" comments are related either to experimental analytes or PT frequency. The PT Board is currently discussing experimental analytes and the Frequency subcommittee is dealing with that issue. Therefore, the remaining comments do not need to be discussed at this time.

CJW asked if there were any other issues to be discussed. No issues were raised.

Call guests were thanked for their participation and the call was adjourned at 1:50 PM PM ET.
