Discussion – Volume 1 Module 1 and Volume 2 Module 2

The committee discussed that the time period between studies has been changed to be calculated based on analysis date as opposed to ship date or study closing date. A new requirement will need to be added to Volume 1 Module 1 to ensure that there be 5 to 7 months between analysis dates of PT samples.

The committee will need to review Volume 2 Module 2 to ensure the appropriate use of analysis dates for consistency with Volume 1 Module 1. The committee will also need to review Volume 2 Module 2 concerning implementation of the review of laboratory reporting levels as required in Volume 1 Module 1.

Handling of Written Comments

There was a concern raised by Mr. Coyner and Mr. Wibby that the PT Committee was not following TNI procedures in the handling of written comments. It was explained that the PT Committee is following an appropriate process as required by TNI. Curtis agreed to contact Ken Jackson and Jerry Parr to seek clarification on the handling of written comments.
