Section 2.9: Jeff asked why it has to be to NIST? He would prefer that this specific reference be removed. Joe agreed with this comment. The TNI standard does not have any requirement to reference NIST. Carl proposed to leave the language of the paragraph, but remove the specific reference to NIST. The subcommittee was in agreement.

Carl will make all final changes and send the SOP out to the subcommittee for a final review and possible approval for submission to the PT Program Executive Committee.
