## DRAFT Minutes of THE NELAC INSTITUTE'S

#### Whole Effluent Toxicity Testing (WET) Subcommittee for Acceptance Criteria April 10, 2013

The meeting was called the order at 1:00 pm EST by Rami Naddy (Chair). Roll call was taken and members present are listed in Attachment A.

The January teleconference meeting minutes were approved by the subcommittee. Committed discussed old business and remaining action items from last meeting. Specific action items and comments were:

- Topic #1: Analytical (i.e., PT toxicity) data regarding potential toxicity differences between dilute mineral water (DMW) and reconstituted freshwater prepared from salts (MHSF). Committee is still considering making a recommendation to combine these datasets for all WET PTs. Committee has a draft paragraph (submitted by Teresa N.) regarding proposed background and recommendation. Tabled from last meeting.
  - Steve R. was concerned that if both datasets were combined that would lead to increased variability (affecting overall accuracy).
  - Teresa N. was going to try and get more data from EPA so can have a better handle on what the implications would be. Wanted to also consider what we would need for a good QA program.
  - o Discussion was tabled to provide more time to gather additional data.
- Topic #2: since 'no toxicity' is a valid and common test result in WET studies that WET PT samples include blanks (i.e., non-toxic samples) as a valid result. Committee has a draft paragraph (submitted by Chris P.) regarding proposed background and recommendation. Tabled from last meeting.
  - O Some of the concerns have been:
    - Is there guidance on selection of PTs (i.e., including blanks), how they fit into promulgated methods, are blanks included in other PT methods, how would this affect the grading of the PTs, is there guidance on selection of PTs (& blanks)?
  - Committee discussed these questions and sounds like blanks are included (by default in other PTs) but committee still wanted to hear from PTP on last topic (guidance).
    - Is there guidance on selection of PTs (i.e., including blanks)? Need more information.
  - o Tabled this discussion so we could get specific input on guidance for preparing PTs and then move forward on whether we put forth a recommendation or not.
- Dropping NOEC from WET PT reporting: More information was provided on our recommendation to drop NOECs from WET PT reporting and just go to point estimates (i.e., IC25 values). Internationally (e.g., Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development, OECD) are also moving toward point estimates and away from traditional hypothesis test endpoints, i.e., NOEC. Need to outline any future steps / approach.
- New Business: Committed discussed reviewing PT instructions on preparing PT test unknowns to ensure they are consistent. Instructions from three PTPs (RTC-Sigma, ERA, and Phenova) was located and sent to committee to review for next meeting.

The meeting concluded at 2:00 pm EST after discussing our next meeting date and time. The next teleconference was scheduled for May 8, 2013 at 1:00 pm EST.
