

# The NELAC Institute (TNI) Quality Systems Committee Meeting Minutes May 12, 2008

The Quality Systems Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on Monday May 12, 2008 at 11:00 AM MST by conference call. The action items are listed in Appendix A and the attendees listed in Appendix B.

First Issue: Status of Standards

The Standards will be available soon on the TNI Website

#### Second Issue: Committee Membership

There are at least four people that have applied to the QS committee and have expressed an interest. The committee was asked what information was needed. This process will be used to add new members next January. Bob will draft an information request for committee review which includes the following:

- The TNI activity for each applicant, include attendance and participation with committees and meetings.
- The availability for meetings, travel and conference calls.
- Short narrative on why you want to be involved with Qualit6y Systems and How I can help.
- Technical expertise with quality systems and testing.

This information request will be sent on or about June 1, 2008 and is due back to the committee by September 1, 2008.

Third Issue: The committee was asked if any clarifications were needed in those sections of the checklist that was in their prevue. This initial attempt at a checklist only specifies the TNI reference, at some point a new checklist will be created with TNI language. This effort will only show that 1) there are not wholesale changes in the standards and 2) where NELAC 2003 sections exist in the new format. The committee need to be careful with technical requirements, like chlorine checking for Micro samples, that have been moved to technical modules. The committee will review the checklist in the June and July conference call.

Tentatively the QS meeting in Washington DC is schedule for the morning of August 11.
