The committees efforts was to assign TNI references to the current NELAC Checklist but to not modify the wording as a guide to show were these NELAC sections exist. The language therefore does not match the TNI Standard.

This effort by the committee showed that 1) there are not wholesale changes in the standards and 2) where NELAC 2003 sections exist in the new format.
