The voting for module 2 by committee members will take place between May 2nd and 7th, 2007. If approved the module will be a Draft Interim Standard and will be voted on by TNI membership in June and July prior to Cambridge.

The committee may need an additional meeting after May 14th to complete Module 3 to 8.
