

The NELAC Institute (TNI) Quality Systems Committee Meeting Minutes June 11, 2007

The Quality Systems Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on Monday June 11th, 2007, at 11:00 noon. Mountain Standard Time (MST). A list of action items is given in Appendix A. A list of participants is given in Appendix B.

This meeting was one of the shortest on record for this committee and focused on a summary of voting Working Draft Standards (WDS) to Draft Interim Standards (DIS). All modules 2 to 7 were voted to become DIS. It was noted that comments received from this committee were mainly grammatical or format and Bob made those changes before sending the modules to the Consensus Standards Development Board. Comments that were made that could not be considered for edits will be returned to committee member so they can vote on this standard with their comment.

Paul gave a brief summary of the uniformity committee activities which were complete by last Friday. The DIS modules will be published for review by June 15^{th} , 2007 and voting will begin around July 1^{st} , 2007. From now until these standards are final this committee will only discuss comments received.

The committee will discuss voting comments received and the format for Cambridge during the next two scheduled conference calls. Bob asked the committee to make comments and approve the minutes from April and May 2007.

The next TNI conference call is scheduled for July 9th, 2007.
