

The NELAC Institute (TNI) Quality Systems Expert Committee

Meeting Minutes

The Quality Systems Expert Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on April 13, 2009 at 1:00 PM EST by conference call. The action items are listed in Appendix A and the attendees listed in Appendix B.

The committee heard that the Consensus Standards Development Board (CSDB) feels it's difficult to set a format for Guidance Documents without knowing the purpose for a given Guidance Document. The discussion among CSDB was to wait and see if there were draft versions of Guidance Documents, and then see if a set format is needed. CSDB determined that it was best to present the Standards 'as is' to the NELAP Board, along with a statement that the Committee doesn't feel Guidance Documents are needed.

Edited versions of the Quality Systems Modules have been submitted to the Chair of the CSDB and to the NELAP Board. If it is agreed that the changes presented are those that we have agreed are editorial, then these will be distributed to the QS Committee. This would give all Committee members the same documents for future work. These documents would include SIO language, so each member will have to acknowledge either having a legal copy of ISO 17025, or will purchase such a copy.

No requests for Standards Interpretation were received by the committee this month. One outstanding issue from last month is still awaiting expert review.

The Committee has been drafted to work on portions of the new Quality Manual Template. Following a brief discussion of the Quality Manual Template, it was decided that Committee members would have a better idea of what is needed by seeing the current version of the Manual. Permission to distribute the Manual among the Committee will be sought. A link provided by Robin Cook to the Florida DEP webpage regarding Florida's interpretation of the standard will also be distributed to the Committee.

The "Chapter 5 Checklist" is of a lower priority than initially felt. It isn't needed for another 15 months (or so). There has been interest expressed by assessors in being

involved in the process of creating the new checklist. Paul will contact Jack Farrell for more details about who wants to be involved, and if there are any ideas on how to best accomplish this. The obvious way seems to be that each part of the Standard needs to be broken into a question, with the presumed answer of 'yes'.

The tentative schedule for the meeting in San Antonio was discussed. Since there is no QS Session scheduled, a working lunch meeting will be planned. A draft schedule will be distributed to the Committee.

Next Meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 11 at 1:00 PM EST.
