

The NELAC Institute (TNI) Quality Systems Expert Committee

Meeting Minutes

The Quality Systems Expert Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on May 11, 2009 at 1:00 PM EST by conference call. The action items are listed in Appendix A and the attendees listed in Appendix B.

There has been no change in the status of the editorial revisions to the Standards. Once these are approved, they will be distributed to all committee members.

No requests for Standards Interpretation were received by the committee this month. One outstanding issue from last month is still awaiting expert review.

There was a discussion of the "needs" for the Quality Manual Template. It is anticipated that implementation of the new standards will be slow, so there is an extended timeframe under which this revision is needed. Clarification is requested regarding the implementation timeframe. Presumably, there will be a hard date set at which point all ABs would convert to the TNI Standard. Fred was asked how DOD might adopt the new standard. Since they aren't under any recognition agreements, they would be free to adopt them at their own pace, possibly quicker than the ABs.

Robin will be making a presentation at FSEA on changes that have been made in the TNI Standard as compared to the NELAC Standard. Information will be requested from Jerry Parr to aid in this talk.

The Committee discussed the six Requests for Standard Interpretation that had been submitted in the previous month. After some debate, and some e-mail discussions, the finalized interpretations were submitted.

New Committee member Gil Dicther (IDEXX Laboratories) introduced himself.

The Committee discussed the Tentative Interim Amendment that arose as a result of one of the Requests for Standards Interpretation. The TIA seemed like it shouldn't be a problem.

Next Meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 8 at 1:00 PM EST.
