

The NELAC Institute (TNI) Quality Systems Expert Committee

Meeting Minutes

The Quality Systems Expert Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on June 8, 2009 at 1:00 PM EST by conference call. The action items are listed in Appendix A and the attendees listed in Appendix B.

The Committee discussed the Tentative Interim Amendment that arose as a result of one of the Requests for Standards Interpretation. There was only one comment submitted regarding the TIA, and the commenter was present on the call. After some discussion, it was decided to revise the TIA by adding some additional language. Paul will find out what the process is for revising the TIA, once the revised language is agreed upon by the Committee. [Following the call, I was informed that we are able to revise the TIA based on feedback. Our revised TIA will be what is submitted.]

No requests for Standards Interpretation were received by the committee this month. We won't necessarily get feedback from the NELACP Board on the outcome of the Interpretations. However, if the Board feels that the response provided is inadequate or requires additional comment, it would be returned to Quality Systems.

A brief draft of the Checklist for the TNI Modules was distributed prior to the call. Part of Module 2 was converted to a table for demonstration purposes. The Committee agreed that this was a suitable format for creating the checklist, so discussions continued on what the next steps would be. Initially, the goal was to assign portions to each committee member. Each item in the Standard would be changed into a question. A concern was raised that if items were paraphrased, the meaning of the Standard would be lost. An offshoot of that discussion was the question of whether or not ISO language could be paraphrased and used under "Fair Use" guidelines. Paul will be investigating that question. It was determined that committee members will review their assigned sections and determine if items need to be deleted from the checklist; marked as not assessable; and possibly subdivided for ease of use. The checklist would be noted as "Does the laboratory comply with the following?" so as to avoid needing to re-write what is in the Standard.

Next Meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 13 at 1:00 PM EST.
