

The NELAC Institute (TNI) Quality Systems Expert Committee

Meeting Minutes

The Quality Systems Expert Committee of The NELAC Institute (TNI) met on December 14, 2009 at 1:00 PM EST by conference call. The action items are listed in Appendix A and the attendees listed in Appendix B.

A quorum of the Committee members was not present for this call, so no official business was conducted.

Minutes from the November 9 meeting were discussed by those on the call, and will be forwarded to Committee members for approval via e-mail.

A rotation of Committee Members was discussed, with consideration given to the start dates of those on the Committee. Terms on TNI Expert Committees are limited to 2 three-year periods. Since TNI was formed in November, 2006, Committee Members serving at that time have just completed a first term. Those members could serve through January 2012. At this point, any member who would be interested in rotating off should contact the Chair. Robert Martino expressed a concern of minimal involvement due to his represented discipline. The Chair expressed a preference that Robert stay on the Committee as a person with an interest in Toxicity Testing.

The Committee discussed 6 requests for Standard Interpretations. 4 of them were follow ups from the previous call. The items will be sent to the Committee for approval via e-mail.

For the meeting in Chicago, the plan is to have the Quality Systems session discuss changes to the Modules before the morning break (making the TIA permanent; addressing the inadvertent inclusion of ISO language). After the morning break, we'll discuss Guidance that should be in existence by that point, along with a request for additional guidance ideas/requests.

Conference Calls will be set up for 2010 on the same schedule as for 2009 (second Monday of the month at 1PM Eastern), unless there is an overwhelming call for change among the Committee members. No call will be scheduled for January, since the meeting in Chicago will occur the week after a call would be held.

Next Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, January 27, at 8:30 AM Central at the Forum on Laboratory Accreditation in Chicago.
