# Top Ten Laboratory Auditing Myths



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**QA is an expensive overhead luxury.**



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**Every auditor has a certain quota of findings, especially at the end of each month.**



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**All corrective actions address root causes and extent of conditions; thereby, avoiding recurrences of findings.**



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**A Priority I finding means the entire laboratory is suspect.**



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**DOECAP audits are accreditation/certification reviews.**



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**SOPs are always tied to method applications.**



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**Laboratories hardly ever miss holding times.**

7. Every auditor has a certain quota of findings.
6. Accredited laboratories are subject to a wide range of conditions, thereby avoiding requirements or findings.
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**Performance Evaluation/Testing samples are handled in the lab exactly the same way as any other environmental sample.**
